6. General Admission Guidelines regarding EWS, Lateral Entry, International Students (NRI, OCI, FN & CIWGC) & Admissions against vacant seats

6.1 Admissions under Economically Weaker Sections (EWS):

As per the provisions made by the Government of Maharashtra (Resolution No. - 4019/-31/16-, dated 12th February 2019) 10% seats shall be reserved for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidates. These 10% seats shall be over & above the sanctioned intake for the respective course.

As per the provision of Government of Maharashtra GR Misc-2022/ pk.91/vishi-4, dt 22.06.2023, **as per the merit 50% Concession in Programme fees/ Scholarship will be given to the 10% of admitted students, belonging to Economically Weaker Section in the respective programme/course.**

The Institute shall ensure 10% of reservation for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) as per the reservation policy for admission, without affecting the reservation percentage of SC/ST/OBC/General.

As per IU Scholarship Policy.

NOTE: EWS vacant seats shall be considered for the lateral entry to Second Year Course(s) with the same reservation policy for admission.

6.2 Lateral Entry to Second Year Undergraduate Degree Course(s):

Lateral Entry to Second Year Undergraduate Degree Course(s) shall be permissible up to a maximum of 10% of the "Approved Intake" which shall be over and above, (supernumerary) of the "Approved Intake", plus the unfilled vacancies of the First year.

6.3 Introduction/ Continuation of Supernumerary Seats for FN/NRI/OCI/CIWGC:

Indira University may fill up to 25% supernumerary seats for international students as per the UGC guidelines which includes FN/NRI/OCI/CIWGC in UG and PG programs, over and above the total sanctioned intake. For Ph.D. admission, there shall be 2 supernumerary seats for foreign students each for every approved research guide of Indira University.

6.4 Admissions against vacant seats

Vacant seats arising out of unfilled vacancies of first year, withdrawal of admissions or year down students shall be filled after verification and recommendation from the equivalence committee.

7. Eligibility

- ✓ To be eligible for admission to Indira University, applicants must fulfil the criteria specified for the respective programs offered by the University.
- ✓ The University may also incorporate additional eligibility or selection requirements as prescribed by the appropriate authority under the Act during the admission process.
- ✓ In instances where the results of Class 12th, HSC, or Graduation are announced after a provisional admission is granted, it is the sole responsibility of the candidate to submit the necessary eligibility documents before the commencement of classes. If the candidate fails to submit the Eligibility documents within stipulated time frame, the admission will stand cancelled.

- An orientation program will be held for new students to help them get familiar with the academic structure, resources, and faculty.

NOTE: All the admissions are considered provisional till all original documents are submitted and eligibility is approved by the registrar.

Conditions:

- To cancel admission, student must send request via the registered email to the email address mentioned in the offer guide, or through the University Student Portal. No other methods will be accepted.
- Refunds will follow the university's rules.
- Refunds will only be given once student provide proof of fee payment, Provisional Seat, and Allotment Letter. The refund will be sent via bank transfer to the account number provided in cancellation request, so make sure to give the correct bank details.
- Refunds will only cover the Programme Fee. There will be no refund for the Application Fees or any other charges.

Important Notes:

- Refunds will be transferred to the student's or parent's bank account through NEFT and will be processed within 20 working days after the cancellation is approved.
- Any disputes regarding the refund will be handled under Pune jurisdiction.
- If a student submits fake scores, their admission will be cancelled immediately without notice, and no fees will be refunded. Legal action may also be taken.

14. Scholarships

1. Merit Scholarships:

- a. **Merit based scholarship 1:** This scholarship is provided at the rate of a 50% fee waiver in total academic / Tuition fee per year for the entire duration of the Programme up to 1% of the total students' intake.
- b. **Merit Based Scholarship 2:** This scholarship is provided at the rate of a 25% fee waiver in total academic/ Tuition fee per or the entire duration of the Programme up to 2% of the total students' intake.

2. Sports Scholarship:

These scholarships are awarded to deserving sports persons based on their participation/winning the prizes at Nationally/Internationally recognized sports competitions/events.

Any candidate who participates/wins a medal at west zone, all India level competitions, national or international level competitions, while studying Indira University or playing for any Govt. sponsored/ Govt. recognized official sports organization is eligible for this Scholarship.

3. Economical Weaker Section (EWS) Scholarship:

The university shall provide 50% of exemption in the fee to 10% students belonging to EWS, irrespective of their caste. (income certificate, 16, income tax return)

4. Dr. Tarita Shankar Scholarship:

This scholarship provides a part tuition Fee waiver as per merit per year for the entire duration of the Program to a maximum 2.5% of total number of girl students admitted. This scholarship will be given to only girl students belonging to EWS category.

5. Scholarship for disabled person:

100% tuition fee waiver to 1 seat in each of the program.

6. Scholarship to the Wards of Martyrs:

Wards of defence forces personnel (Army, Navy, Air Force, Indian Coast Guard and NSG) 'Killed in Action' shall be provided 50% Concession in the tuition fee in all academic years. For continuation of scholarships to successive years student must have GPA more than or equal to 8.

7. Ph.D. Research Assistant Fellowship:

There shall be Ph.D. Research Assistant Fellowship for the Ph.D. Research Projects. A sum of Rs. 10,000/- each for two merit students per school per month for 2 years within the entire Indira University will be awarded to the selected Ph.D. Research students. However, the final decision will be taken by the Scholarship Committee of Indira University.

The Scholarship Policy will be in effect from the Academic Year 2025-26.

Process to apply for scholarship will be notified to all the students at the time of commencement of classes except students belonging to EWS category who will apply at the time of admission application with valid documents.

15. Ph.D. Program at Indira University

Indira University offers a comprehensive Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) program in various streams:

1. Business Studies - Management
2. Information Technology
3. Commerce and Economics
4. Pharmaceutical Sciences
5. Liberal Arts & Allied subjects

Duration of Program

- The Ph.D. program shall be for a minimum duration of three (3) years, including course work, and a maximum duration of six (6) years from the date of admission to the Ph. D. program. Pre-Ph.D. presentations will be allowed only after the completion of 3 years.
- A maximum of an additional two (2) years can be given through a process of re-registration as per the Statute/Ordinance/Regulation of the University concerned, provided, however, that the total period or completion of a Ph.D. program should not exceed eight (8) years from the date of admission in the Ph.D. Program
- Provided further that, female Ph.D. Scholars and Specially abled candidates (having more than 40% disability) may be allowed an additional relaxation of two (2) years; however, the total period for completion of a Ph. D program in such cases should not exceed ten (10) years from the date of admission in the Ph.D. program.
- Female Ph.D. Scholars may be provided Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave for up to 240 days in the entire duration of the Ph. D. program of a maximum of 10 years from the date of admission to the Ph.D. Program.

Procedure for admission

Admissions to the Ph.D. program at Indira University are conducted in accordance with criteria established by the university, aligning with guidelines from the University Grants Commission (UGC) and other relevant statutory bodies. The process also incorporates the reservation policies of the State Government, which may be updated periodically.

Application Submission:

Prospective candidates must submit a completed application form along with the necessary documents, including academic transcripts, proof of identity, and any other documents specified by the university.

Indira University Common Entrance Test (Ph.D.) IUCET-(Ph.D.) / NET (UGC):

Candidates seeking admission to the Ph.D. program at Indira University must qualify through the Indira University Common Entrance Test (Ph.D.) IUCET-(Ph.D.) / UGC-NET/ GATE/ GPAT (Valid Score). The entrance examination evaluates applicants on research aptitude, subject knowledge, and analytical skills, ensuring they meet the academic and research standards required for the programme.

Ph.D. admission policy subject to change as per the regulations stated by UGC from time to time.

Interview:

Candidates who are shortlisted based on their performance in the entrance examination will be invited for a personal interview. During the interview, the panel will evaluate the candidate's research interests, academic background, and suitability for the Ph.D. program.

Final Selection:

The final selection of candidates will be based on their performance in both the entrance examination and the interview for understanding the research acumen is conducted. , Students will present the synopsis for the area of interest finalisation once the candidate has completed the interview process.

Ph.D. Research Assistant Fellowship:

Indira University offers a Ph.D. Research Assistant Fellowship to support doctoral research projects. A stipend of Rs. 10,000 per month for two years is awarded to students per school within the university. The final selection is determined by the board of research.

16. International Admissions

General Guidelines:

1. The foreign students will be admitted at Indira University as per the rules, regulations & guidelines issued by the UGC & other statutory authority or recognised bodies by the Government of India or the concerned Ministry from time to time.
2. International students are admitted based on the equivalence of their entry qualification, as recognized by AIU, UGC or other recognized bodies.
3. It is pertinent to note that it is mandatory for all the foreign students coming for higher studies to India to mandatorily register on the Study in India (SII) portal & quote their Unique ID generated in their Visa applications.
4. A transparent admission process will be followed for all International applicants & students can visit the website of the University for entire process.
5. Non-Resident of India (NRI) or Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) or Children of Indian Workers in Gulf & South East Asia (CIWGC) have to upload necessary documentary evidences in a specified format at Indira University website.
6. International students (Foreign Nationals) must possess a valid Foreign Passport.

Supernumerary Seats:

1. Indira University may fill up to 25% supernumerary seats for international students which includes Foreign Nationals/NRI/OCI/CIWGC in UG and PG programs, over and above the total sanctioned intake. For Ph. D admission, there shall be 2 supernumerary seats for foreign students each for every approved research guide of Indira University.
2. Seats under Student Exchange Programs or MOU's between Institutions or Governments will not be included in this 25%.
3. Unfilled Supernumerary seats will not be allocated to domestic students.
4. The distribution of seats among various schools and programs will be based on eligibility, available infrastructure and faculty.

Online Admission Application Process:

STEP 1: The students will register online on the Indira University Website & fill the application form & upload the required documents for Eligibility verification. The eligibility will be determined based on equivalent qualifications recognized by UGC or other regulatory bodies. The student shall be issued with a unique ID which will be required for further communication with the University. The applications will be invited online through the official Indira University website.

STEP 2: After the eligibility verification is completed, the merit list will be uploaded on official website of the Indira University & an offer letter (conditional /unconditional) shall be issued & sent to the student's registered email id.

STEP 3: The student should make the fee payment as prescribed in the offer letter by bank transfer/wire transfer/online payment & submit the receipt along with the proof of the transaction.

STEP 4: After the confirmation of the fees received by the University Accounts Department, an acceptance letter (visa letter) & a bonafide letter will be issued which is required to apply for the student visa at the nearest Indian Embassy/ High Commission in student's home country. No foreign student would be able to get a student visa without registering on the STUDY IN INDIA PORTAL (SII) so student must ensure that they register on the Study in India portal & generate their Unique Id which is mandatory to proceed for the visa application.

STEP 5: The seats remaining vacant after the merit list will be filled through on the spot admission.

Admission will be granted on a merit basis, and additional bridge courses may be required for specific programs.

2. Registration with the Foreign Regional Registration Office (FRRO) within 14 days of arrival in India is mandatory.
3. Indira University will provide assistance with visa-related queries and FRRO compliance.

International Student Support Services:

1. **"Office for International Affairs"** of Indira University will assist International Students.
2. **"Office for International Affairs"** will be responsible for undertaking various activities such as welcoming & supporting foreign students, single point of contact for carrying out collaborative activities with foreign institutions, addressing the grievances of foreign students in all matters, single point of contact for registration with FRRO/e-FRRO & to extend all possible help to the foreign students to adapt to the new cultural environment & make their stay in India comfortable & enriching.
3. Year-wise details of international student admissions will be maintained and published on the university website.
4. Cultural orientation programs will be conducted to help students integrate into the academic and social environment.

Ph.D. Admissions for International Students:

1. Admission to Ph.D. programs will follow UGC regulations.
2. Supernumerary seats for Ph.D. programs will be governed by UGC guidelines.

Compliance with Government Regulations:

1. Indira University will adhere to all Government of India policies regarding admissions of international students.
2. All students must comply with rules regarding visas, FRRO, and residency permits as per Government of India norms.
