		The process begins at the departmental level, where
		the curriculum is initially formulated. This stage is
		led by the Area Chairs, who convene meetings with
		all faculty members of the department. Faculty
		collectively deliberate on academic requirements,
		student learning outcomes, and emerging trends in
		their respective domains. At this stage, detailed course structures, syllabi, and teaching-learning
		methodologies are proposed, keeping in mind both
		academic depth and employability requirements.
		Board of Studies (BoS) Review
		Once prepared at the departmental level, the draft
		curriculum is submitted to the Board of Studies
		(BoS). The BoS at Indira University is constituted
		to ensure broad-based and balanced input. It
		includes representation from academia, industry
		experts, alumni, and other relevant stakeholders,
		thus integrating multiple perspectives into the
		review process. The BoS scrutinizes the proposed
		curriculum thoroughly, evaluates its relevance, and
		suggests modifications to strengthen its academic
		quality and industry alignment.
		Academic Council Approval
		After incorporating the BoS recommendations, the
		revised curriculum is forwarded to the Academic
		Council, the apex academic authority of the
		University. The Academic Council undertakes a
		comprehensive review, examining the curriculum
		from the perspective of compliance with regulatory
		frameworks, academic coherence, and long-term
		institutional objectives. The Council may propose
		further refinements, after which the curriculum is
		formally approved for implementation.
		Current Status of Curriculum
		In the most recent cycle of curriculum development,
		the course structures for all academic years across

		various schools of the University have been designed and reviewed. Presently, the detailed first-year curriculum of all programmes under each school has been thoroughly vetted and approved by both the Board of Studies and the Academic Council. This is how we have ensured that the academic journey of students begins on a robust, well-structured foundation while higher-year curricula are continually refined to incorporate emerging knowledge areas and industry expectations.

5.4	Furnish details of the following aspects of curriculum design: Innovation such as modular curricula Inter/multidisciplinary approach	At Indira University, innovation in curriculum design is embedded through the adoption of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 framework across all undergraduate and postgraduate programmes, with the exception of those regulated by professional statutory councils such as the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI). In alignment with global standards of quality, the University also follows the Outcome Based Education (OBE) model, ensuring that every programme is mapped to clearly defined learning outcomes, competencies, and measurable achievements that prepare students for professional excellence and lifelong learning. The University ensures that modularity, interdisciplinarity, and multidisciplinary learning are integral to academic structures, thereby enhancing flexibility, choice, and holistic education. Undergraduate Programmes All undergraduate programmes across schools (except Pharmacy) follow the NEP framework. The curricula are designed in a modular format, with credits distributed across foundational, core, elective, skill-based, and value-added courses. This structure allows students to progress systematically while exploring diverse academic areas. Interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary opportunities are provided through open electives, value-added courses, and field projects that enable students to combine learning from different schools, such as integrating computer science with economics, or management with liberal arts. This flexibility ensures that learners are not confined to a

		single discipline but are equipped with broad-based competencies. MBA and Postgraduate Programmes The MBA programme is also based on a modular curriculum. Students undertake foundational modules in management and are then provided with the choice of selecting major and minor specialisations. This structure enables interdisciplinary integration, as students can combine, for example, Marketing with Business Analytics or Finance with Human Resource Management. The modular approach ensures that students acquire both depth in their chosen major and breadth across complementary disciplines. Other postgraduate programmes similarly follow NEP guidelines, which emphasize modularity
		through well-defined credit-based systems and continuous assessment methods. Interdisciplinary exposure is facilitated through research projects, electives across schools. This approach fosters intellectual curiosity and prepares students for
		dynamic professional landscapes where cross-domain knowledge is highly valued.
		School of Pharmacy The School of Pharmacy follows a curriculum mandated by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI). The regulatory framework prescribes a structured syllabus. The University supplements it with enrichment opportunities such as guest lectures, industry exposure, and collaborative projects and IU level Core credits. This ensures that Pharmacy students also benefit from an expanded learning ecosystem while remaining compliant with PCI norms.

Internships and On-the-Job Training

The Internship/Apprenticeship Programme are integral to most programmes. These provide students with hands-on exposure to workplace dynamics, industry practices, and emerging trends in their domains. Most UG programmes also include On-the-Job Training (OJT), allowing students to gain continuous practical experience alongside their academic study.

Industry Interaction and Exposure

Students across schools benefit from seminars, guest lectures, workshops, and industry visits that provide exposure to current trends, technologies, and professional practices. Industry experts regularly interact with students, bridging the gap between theory and application.

International Exposure and Outdoor Training
Select programmes also offer international exposure
opportunities through collaborations and global
immersion visits. Additionally, outdoor
management training programmes are conducted to
build teamwork, leadership, and decision-making
skills in challenging environments.

Impact on Students

These opportunities collectively nurture professional readiness, practical problem-solving, leadership, and social awareness. Students graduate not only with strong disciplinary foundations but also with adaptability, cross-cultural competence, and confidence to succeed in diverse professional and societal contexts.

At Indira University, the examination system is designed to ensure rigorous, transparent, and outcome-based evaluation across all Schools, in alignment with University ordinances, statutory body guidelines (AICTE, PCI, UGC), and NEP 2020 recommendations. All programmes follow a structured framework comprising Term End Assessments (TEAs) and Continuous Comprehensive Assessments (CCAs), with both components mapped to the Course Outcomes (COs) and their corresponding Bloom's Taxonomy (BT) levels.

TEAs serve as summative assessments and are conducted in written, practical, or mixed modes depending on the nature of the programme. They include case-based and application-oriented questions, analytical problem-solving, simulations, project demonstrations, and viva-voce examinations. CCAs act as formative assessments

and include activities such projects, as presentations, fieldwork, role plays, online quizzes, research assignments, and skill demonstrations. This dual-component approach ensures balanced coverage of lower-, middle-, and higher-order cognitive skills, while promoting both conceptual mastery and practical application. Question papers for TEAs are set by qualified

subject experts approved by the University's Board of Studies (BoS) and vetted for CO-BT mapping, academic integrity, and relevance to the curriculum. CCAs are designed by course faculty within the same mapping framework to ensure that each CO is assessed at least once in a semester through TEA and/or CCA.

All Schools follow common quality assurance mechanisms:

Question paper moderation to ensure relevance, clarity, and balance.

Evaluation schemes with rubrics to promote objectivity and consistency.

Academic audits and result analyses for continuous improvement.

Adherence to statutory guidelines (e.g., PCI for pharmacy programmes).

This unified approach allows flexibility for discipline-specific assessment methods while maintaining a university-wide standard transparency, fairness, and academic excellence.

5.8 scripts does the University follow? Whether external experts are invited practical for evaluation?

What methods of evaluation of answer Yes, the external experts are invited for evaluation. t Indira University, evaluation of answer scripts and assessments follows structured, a transparent, and quality-assured process that integrates both internal and external expertise to maintain academic rigor and credibility.

> For Term End Assessments (TEAs), a three-set question paper system is followed for every subject, prepared by two appointed paper setters under the supervision of a Chairperson. All papers are validated for Course Outcome (CO)-Bloom's Taxonomy (BT) alignment using a documented validation flowchart. As a policy, at least 50% of paper setters are external subject experts drawn from academia, industry, or professional bodies, ensuring impartiality and domain relevance. In experts cases where suitable external unavailable, qualified internal faculty are appointed. Before release, all question papers undergo confidential scrutiny by the Controller Examinations (CoE) for content accuracy, CO mapping, language clarity, and typographical

checks. Written TEAs are evaluated through the Evaluation Management Onscreen System (OEMS), in which each answer script is barcoded to mask student identity, ensuring complete anonymity of evaluators. OEMS also enables auto-totalling, multi-level quality checks, and secure digital archiving of evaluated scripts. Moderation is carried out as per the University's defined scenarios and sampling rules to ensure fairness, accuracy, and consistency in evaluation: Borderline failures (within $\leq 10\%$ of total marks): 100% moderation of the answer book to ensure fairness in pass-fail decisions. High scorers (>80%): 100% moderation of the answer book to verify consistency and rigor in awarding top grades. Average scorers (between passing marks and <70%): Moderation of 5% of answer books through random sampling to check general accuracy. All answer books (general rule): Moderator verifies that internal choices are considered correctly, marks are awarded strictly as per allocation, and all questions/sub-questions have been evaluated. Continuous Comprehensive Assessments (CCAs) and practical examinations are evaluated using structured rubrics to promote transparency and consistency. Depending on the programme, practical assessments may involve laboratory experiments, industry-linked projects, fieldwork, creative performances, coding challenges, simulations. These are often jointly assessed by internal faculty and external evaluators from relevant industries or professional domains, ensuring that assessment standards meet both academic and industry benchmarks. All assessment records, including evaluated scripts, rubrics, and moderation reports, are securely archived for audit and review. Step 1 – Blueprint-Based Preparation Every paper setter receives a CO–BT–Marks Distribution Blueprint approved by the Controller of Examinations (CoE). The blueprint ensures proportionate coverage of all COs for the course, with weightage mapped to the CO's significance and the intended BT level.

Step 2 – CO–BT Mapping and Initial Draft
The paper setter designs questions explicitly
tagged to the mapped CO and BT level before
submission. PG papers focus more on higher-order
BT levels (Analyse–Evaluate–Create), while UG
papers maintain balanced coverage across
Remember–Apply–Analyse levels.

Step 3 – Chairman's Review
The School's Chairman of Examinations reviews
the paper to ensure accuracy of CO–BT alignment,
adherence to the blueprint, and appropriateness of
difficulty levels.

Step 4 – Area Chair's Quality Assurance
The Area Chair (or equivalent academic lead)
examines the paper for overall quality, clarity,
absence of ambiguity, diversity of question types,
and coverage of the syllabus. This includes
checking if the paper has a balanced mix of
conceptual, application-based, analytical, and caseintegrated questions relevant to the discipline.

Step 5 – Moderation Moderation is carried out as per University guidelines to ensure fairness and accuracy:

Borderline failures (≤10% short of passing marks) – 100% moderation.

High scorers (>80%) – 100% moderation.

Average scorers -5% of answer books (random sampling).

Moderation checks include whether internal choice is applied correctly, marks are proportionate to question weightage, and all sub-parts are evaluated.

Step 6 – CoE Verification
The CoE's office conducts the final verification to ensure compliance with the blueprint, CO–BT

Senior Supervisors Senior Supervisor – External: Assigned to each examination block, typically from another school or an external institution; ensures adherence to

COE protocols, prevents malpractice, and maintains discipline.

Senior Supervisor – Internal: From the home school; coordinates invigilators, manages operational logistics, and serves as the first point of escalation for on-the-spot decisions.

4. Invigilators

Appointed exclusively from the home school to ensure subject familiarity and effective handling of course-specific examination needs.

5. Flying Squad

A mobile inspection team appointed by the COE to conduct surprise checks during examinations.

UG courses: Paper setters and examiners generally hold a postgraduate degree in the relevant discipline with at least five years of experience.

PG courses: Preference given to PhD holders or equivalent industry experts.

Skills-intensive programmes (e.g., performing arts, pharmacy, engineering) may include practising professionals and industry specialists as examiners.

7. Conflict of Interest & Confidentiality

All appointed personnel sign a confidentiality agreement and a conflict-of-interest declaration.

Any person with a potential conflict (e.g., direct relation to candidates) is ineligible for appointment for that exam cycle.

8. Training & Orientation

All new paper setters, examiners, and senior supervisors undergo orientation on CO–BT alignment, University assessment philosophy, and moderation processes.

9. Regulatory Alignment

Discipline-specific norms (PCI for Pharmacy etc.) are integrated into the appointment process.
