She further informed that, the Academic Council in a private university is the principal academic body of the university and shall, subject to the provisions of this Act and the rules, Statutes or Ordinances made thereunder, co-ordinate and exercise general supervision over the academic policies of the university. The powers and functions of the Academic Council are as may be prescribed by the Statutes. Few of the functions are –</p> <div><div>1. To approve all the ordinances and regulations and submit the same to Board of Management and Governing Body.</div><div>2.
